

## Proposed changes to the IOI Regulations (General)

May 2005 / July 2005

This document contains a list of proposed changes to the existing regulations. All numberings correspond to the current version (marked *July 2004 - Approved by GA, IOI 2003* on cover page). Where possible, the relevant statute, explication or appendix has been reproduced, where:

- Text in a normal font indicates text from the existing regulation which is not changing.
- **Text in a bold font indicates text which is to be added.**
- ~~Text which has been outlined indicates text which is to be removed.~~
- *Text in italics is a comment and will not appear in the regulations.*

Regulations have been reproduced in full except, in the case of some of the regulations, where they contained multiple points not directly relevant to the proposed change. In these cases a comment in square brackets indicates unquoted text.

### S6.3 (regarding translations)

The SC must present printed Competition Procedures, Judging Procedures and Competition Tasks at appropriate meetings of the GA for approval. The Delegation Leaders may translate the approved Competition Procedures and Competition Tasks into their national languages, without giving any additional information. **Translations should remain faithful to the original text.** All translated tasks must be made available for scrutiny, during the competition days, by all Delegations during IOI'n.

**N6.3** (NB: Recall that “notes provide background notes and for information purposes. They do not form part of the formal Regulations”)

**Translations are provided to make the competition accessible to all students. Translations should remain faithful so that descriptions are consistent for all contestants.**

### A3.5 (IC nominations)

Nominations for IC:

- Nominated individuals' names are to be submitted to the ED. ~~not later than 30 days before the IOI.~~
- Nominations must be proposed and seconded, by Countries or individuals.
- Nominations must be accompanied by brief motivation, from the nominators and nominee, of no more than half an A4 page.
- The nominee must agree to their nomination.
- ~~All nominations are to be circulated to participating countries at least 14 days before an IOI.~~
- ~~All nominations will be made known at the first GA meeting.~~
- The Chairman of IC will call for further nominations at the first GA meeting.
- Nominees may make a brief presentation.
- **The closing date for nominations is the GA meeting “Before the second Competition period and after Delegation Leaders are segregated from their Contestants” (see S3.2).**

### S2.8 (Additional participants, whose cost is not expected to be covered by a Host Country:)

- Adjunct to the Team: A person who has a duty adjunct to the team (e.g. nurse, chaperon **or translator**).

### A5.3 (Present Host obligations)

**The Present Host's guidelines for catering must take into account different cultural and religious dietary requirements. In particular, vegetarian food must be available at all meals, the contents of dishes should be clearly indicated, and separate utensils and plates should be used for food which may be unacceptable to some participants (e.g. pork).**

#### **E5.11**

There will be an annual program to recognize individuals for their contribution to the activities of IOI. This program will be managed by the IC.

Candidates for nomination should:

- Have attended IOI for at least 5 years as a member an official IOI body or delegation.
- Made a significant contribution to the activities and development of IOI.
- Not be current members of IC or ISC.

Individuals who have passed away may be nominated.

The IC will call for nominations from members of the IOI community for candidates deserving of recognition. The IC will determine the recipient(s) and advise the Organising Committee for IOI'n.
